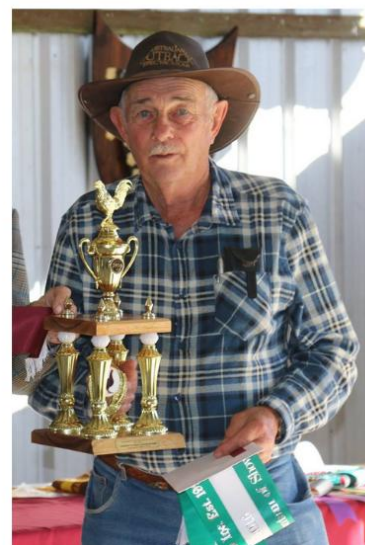

Conditions of show

1. For the purpose of this show, the following terminology will apply:

- a) PIT GAME refers to birds of NORMAL feathering
- b) HENFEATHER refer to birds predominantly HENFEATHERED.

c) PEACOMB refers to birds with a pea or triple comb.

2. All exhibits shall be penned by 8.00am on the show date and are not to be removed until judging is final and presentation of awards is concluded.

3. *Qld Exhibitors must hold a current FCAQI Certificate, the number of which is to be quoted on the entry form. Certificates maybe purchased prior to show day online via the FCAQI website.*

4. Once judging has commenced no exhibitor may interfere or remove an exhibit from a pen without the consent of the Chief Steward.

5. The Club will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss, mis delivery or damage to exhibits.

6. Waters will be provided in all pens by the club, but the filling of them remains the responsibility of the exhibit's owner. The club will not be held responsible for any unwatered birds on the day. However, the club reserves the right to provide water to birds at their discretion.

7. Birds in single classes are only eligible for those awards.

8. Birds over twelve (12) months will judge as adults.

9. Any person found removing eggs from the exhibit pens will be prosecuted unless given permission by the Chief Steward.

10. Permanent identification legs bands such as those used for NLIS, NAPIS etc are acceptable.

11. No entries will be accepted on the day of the show. **ENTRIES MUST BE ENTERED USING THE CLUB'S ENTRY FORM & SUBMITTED BEFORE CLOSING DATE (3rd JULY 2026) The club's preferred method of payment is bank transfer at the time of submitting entry forms.**

12. Should any dispute for which there is no specific rules arise, the matter in dispute shall be referred to the Club Committee, the decision of which is final.

13. All major champions and reserve birds that are in contention for pit of show and reserve will be placed in the champion pens out front before they are awarded.

14. **Decisions made by the elected judges are final.**

15. The Committee reserves the right to amend the Schedule and/or prizes if necessary and without notice.

16. All birds exhibited are to be the Bonafede property of the exhibitor.

17. Birds exhibited are to be free of vermin and disease or entries will automatically be removed from pens at the direction of the Chief Steward.

18. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, the decision of which is final.

19. To be eligible for Member's entry fee, the membership fee must also be included with total fees.

20. Junior Exhibitors, this is a separate section within the overall show. Juniors compete against other Juniors and exhibits in this section are ineligible for open class awards.

21. Junior exhibitors to be 16 years and under and over 4 years of age, and present on show day.

22. Exhibit must be penned by the Junior to which it belongs.

23. A Junior exhibitor must own and have in their possession their entries for a period of six months prior to the show, the above conditions will be enforced by the committee.

24. If a Junior chooses to exhibit a fowl in the open class, that exhibit then becomes ineligible for awards on offer in the Junior section.

25. Pens will be available for anyone wishing to sell birds, at their own discretion. Limit of 3 birds per pen \$5 per pen (to be paid with entries). QPGFC takes no responsibility for sale of birds & payment (name & price to be placed on pens by vendor).

26. If an exhibitor wishes to protest on a ruling it will cost the exhibitor protesting \$50 non-refundable for an enquiry to occur by the committee.

27. Birds shall not be moved from the Pavilion until the show is deemed complete or permission is granted by the Chief Stewart. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiting of all winnings attained during the show. Those winnings will then remain the property of the Qld Pit Game Fowl Club Inc.

28. The Qld Pit Game Fowl Club Inc. reserves the right to refuse any entries.

29. A one off \$5 pen cleaning fee is chargeable to all exhibitors. Excluding Juniors.

Due to the condition of the plainface shield the committee has come to the decision that all perpetual's shall remain in the clubs keeping permanently, the winners of these awards can have their photo taken with these awards on the day. The winners will be compensated for this with trophies designed by the club for the winner to keep.

The Pit Cock Badge

The Pit Cock badge for bird of show has been modelled after Mark Marshall's depiction and is stamped with a number to coincide with the club year of the show in which it was won. 120 pins were purchased.
