- *NO commission charge*
- No Birds Penned after 9.30am Saturday of show.
- Penning available Friday 4pm by prior arrangement.
- No entries accepted after the closing date or when limit is reached
- Birds for sale will be in a separate area of the shed to the Show Birds, so can't enter in both show and sale.
- Bring your own boxes for purchased birds.
- Only Purebred / Exhibition Birds accepted, Club reserves the right to refuse birds
- Caged Birds are to have their own cages which will be sold with the lot.
- **No birds are to be removed from pens before the END OF THE SHOW.** No exceptions.
- Birds remain the owner's responsibility until transferred to the buyer.
- Sellers will release Birds directly to buyer after obtaining payment.
- Lots must be bonafide property of the vendor.
